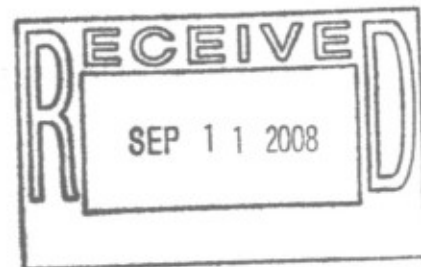

WHEREAS, the Ottawa County Board of Commissioners supports efforts to assure the safety of children in daycare and babysitting facilities; and,

WHEREAS, Representative Arlan Meekhof has drafted legislation to amend Act 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, entitled the "Stille-DeRossett-Hale Single State Construction Code Act," MCL 125.1501 et seq., to provide that a local governmental entity may, by ordinance, require the installation of windows to allow the viewing of occupants of nurseries and playrooms within babysitting facilities, thereby better assuring the safety of children in those facilities, a copy of which proposed legislation is attached to this Resolution;



NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Ottawa County Board of Commissioners supports and endorses passage of Representative Arlan Meekhof's proposed legislation to amend Act 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, entitled the "Stille-DeRossett-Hale Single State Construction Code Act," MCL 125.1501 et seq., to provide that a local governmental entity may, by ordinance, require the installation of windows to allow the viewing of occupants of nurseries and playrooms within babysitting facilities, thereby better assuring the safety of children in those facilities; and,
