

## Resolution 2020-7 DICKINSON COUNTY, MICHIGAN DECLARATION OF A "LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY"

To: Commanding Officer – Emergency Management and Homeland Security Division, Michigan State Police; District (8) Emergency Management and Homeland Security Division Coordinator

On (March 16, 2020 and continuing) the (County of Dickinson, Michigan) because of (Corona Virus, COVID-19, The State of Emergency declared by the Governor of the State of Michigan and a National State of Emergency declared by the President of the United States), as a result of this situation, the following conditions exist:

(Dickinson County, including all cities and townships within this county, are experiencing limited access to first responder health and safety resources.

Additionally, there may be an impact on the elderly and students who are provided meals and others services. With schools and senior center closings from the Governor's Declaration, this may place a hardship on those providers to get those services to their clients and students.

Also, because of the monitoring requirements that is placed on the local health department personnel, additional staff may be needed if the current status of health concerns deteriorates. Dickinson County has limited resources to combat and respond to the COVID-19 Pandemic.

Therefore, as (Chairperson, of the Board of Commissioners) of (Dickinson County), in accordance with Section 10 of 1976 PA 390, as amended, I hereby declare that a "state of emergency" exists within our jurisdiction, that the response and recovery elements of our emergency operations plan have been activated, and that local resources are being utilized to the fullest possible extent.
