



MAC Board Election Procedures

Eligible Voters

Only commissioners of member MAC counties who are registered for the conference at which the election will occur are eligible to vote in MAC elections.

Voting for a Regional Director

Regional directors are elected by the caucus for that region ONLY. Voting is by county; each county in the region gets one (1) vote. A county does not get to vote unless at least one member is present at the caucus.

Voting for an At-large Director

In each caucus, each commissioner gets to cast one (1) vote per at-large seat up. The candidate winning the majority in a caucus wins that caucus.

A candidate that wins a minimum of four (4) caucuses is elected.

If no such majority is reached, the matter moves to the Business Meeting.
