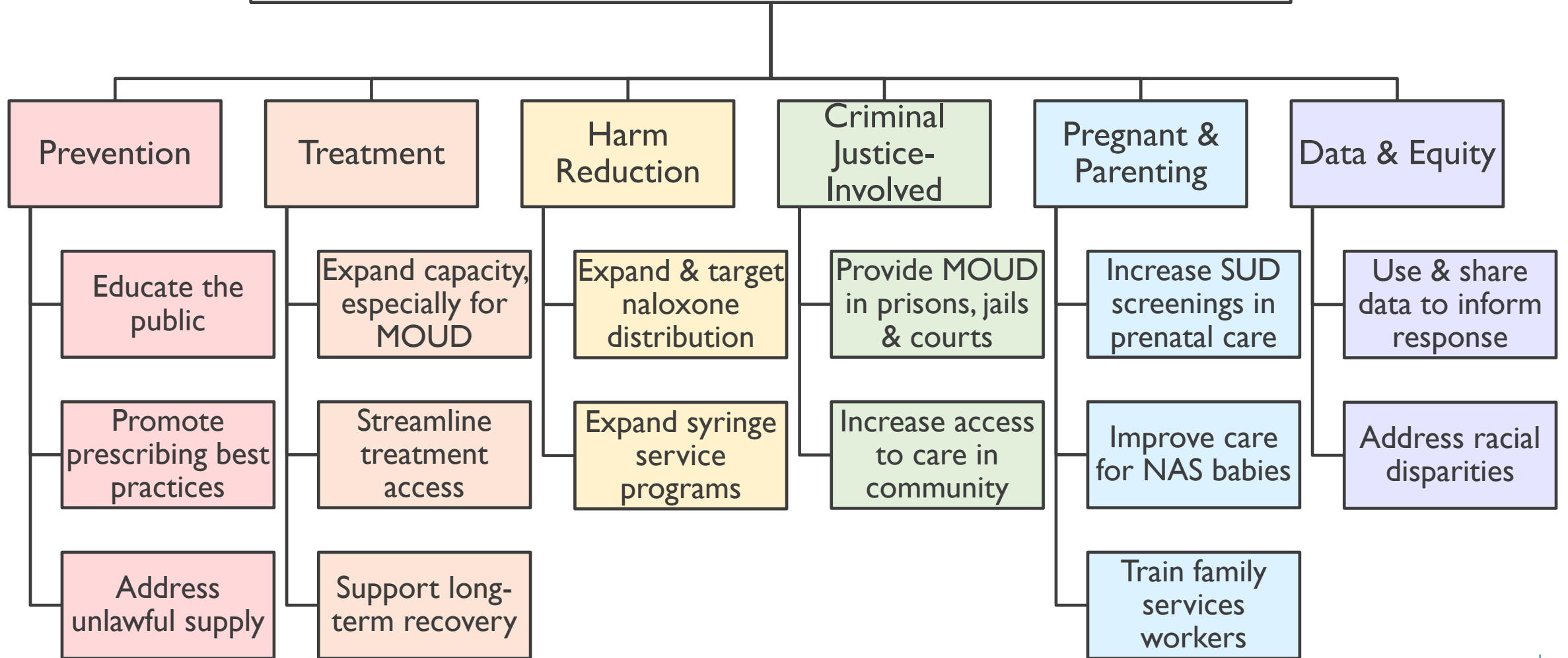


# 2020 Strategy: Turning the Tide on the Opioid Epidemic



## SOR II: SIGNIFICANT INVESTMENTS

Category	Projects	Approx. Scale
Prevention	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ SUD prevention programs in schools, after-school programs</li><li>▪ Practical guidelines on safer prescribing</li></ul>	\$3.85 million
Treatment & Recovery	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Opioid &amp; stimulant use disorder treatment coverage</li><li>▪ Case management</li><li>▪ Peer recovery coaches</li><li>▪ Housing, transportation, mobile care units</li><li>▪ Metric scorecards for providers with data on patient outcomes</li><li>▪ Provider incentives &amp; start-up costs for new MAT</li><li>▪ Clinical support for MAT providers</li><li>▪ Contingency management incentives</li><li>▪ Addressing racial disparities in MAT access &amp; outcomes</li></ul>	\$14.8 million

Overdose Acute Care	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ MAT in emergency departments</li><li>▪ Post-overdose rapid response programs</li></ul>	\$3.25 million
Harm Reduction	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Naloxone distribution for high-risk individuals &amp; Online Naloxone Portal</li><li>▪ Syringe service programs</li><li>▪ Engagement centers for individuals in active use</li></ul>	\$4 million
Intersection with Criminal Justice System	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Jail-based MAT</li><li>▪ Front-end diversion programming &amp; Angel Program</li><li>▪ Treatment courts &amp; judicial training</li><li>▪ Reentry support</li></ul>	\$6.3 million

Category	Projects	Approx. Scale
Intersection with Pregnancy & Prenatal Care	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ SUD screening in prenatal care</li><li>▪ 'Rooming In' for infants with neonatal abstinence syndrome</li></ul>	\$1.4 million
Data & Equity	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Development of quality metric scorecards for providers</li><li>▪ Local surveillance reports &amp; System for Overdose Surveillance, to guide service planning</li><li>▪ Community engagement &amp; anti-stigma work in majority-minority neighborhoods</li><li>▪ Tribal response grants</li></ul>	\$2.8 million
