What is it?

- Integrates various MAC trainings and materials from NACo, MSU Extension and state of Michigan
- “Graduation” runs on a 2-year cycle
- Qualifying credits began in 2018



How Do I Participate?

- Just sign up for designated MAC conference events, MSUE trainings, etc.



What Do I Get?

Two qualification levels

- “Certified” = those who have reached 10 credit hours over a 2-year period
- “Advanced” = those who have reached 20 credit hours over a 4-year period

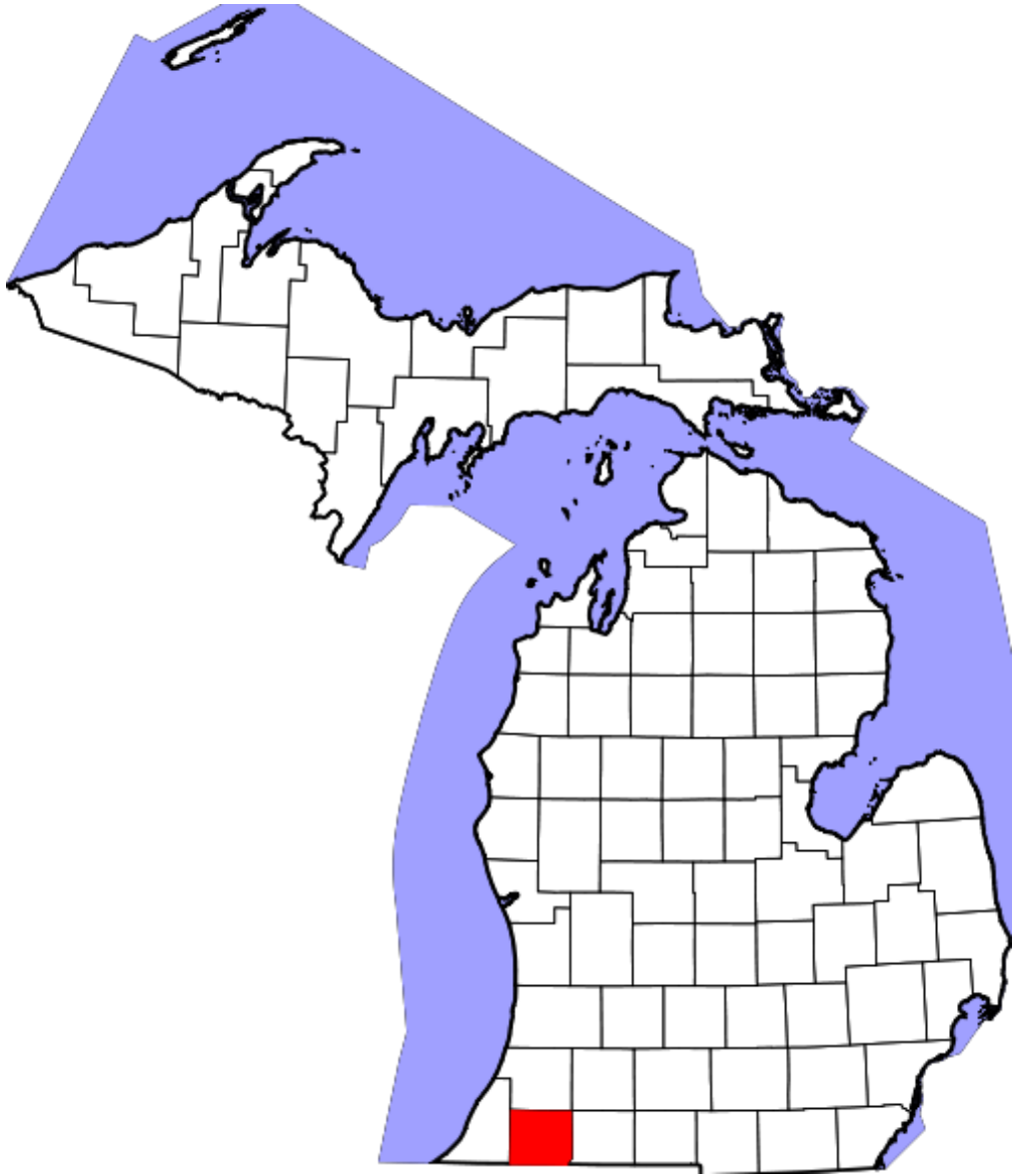

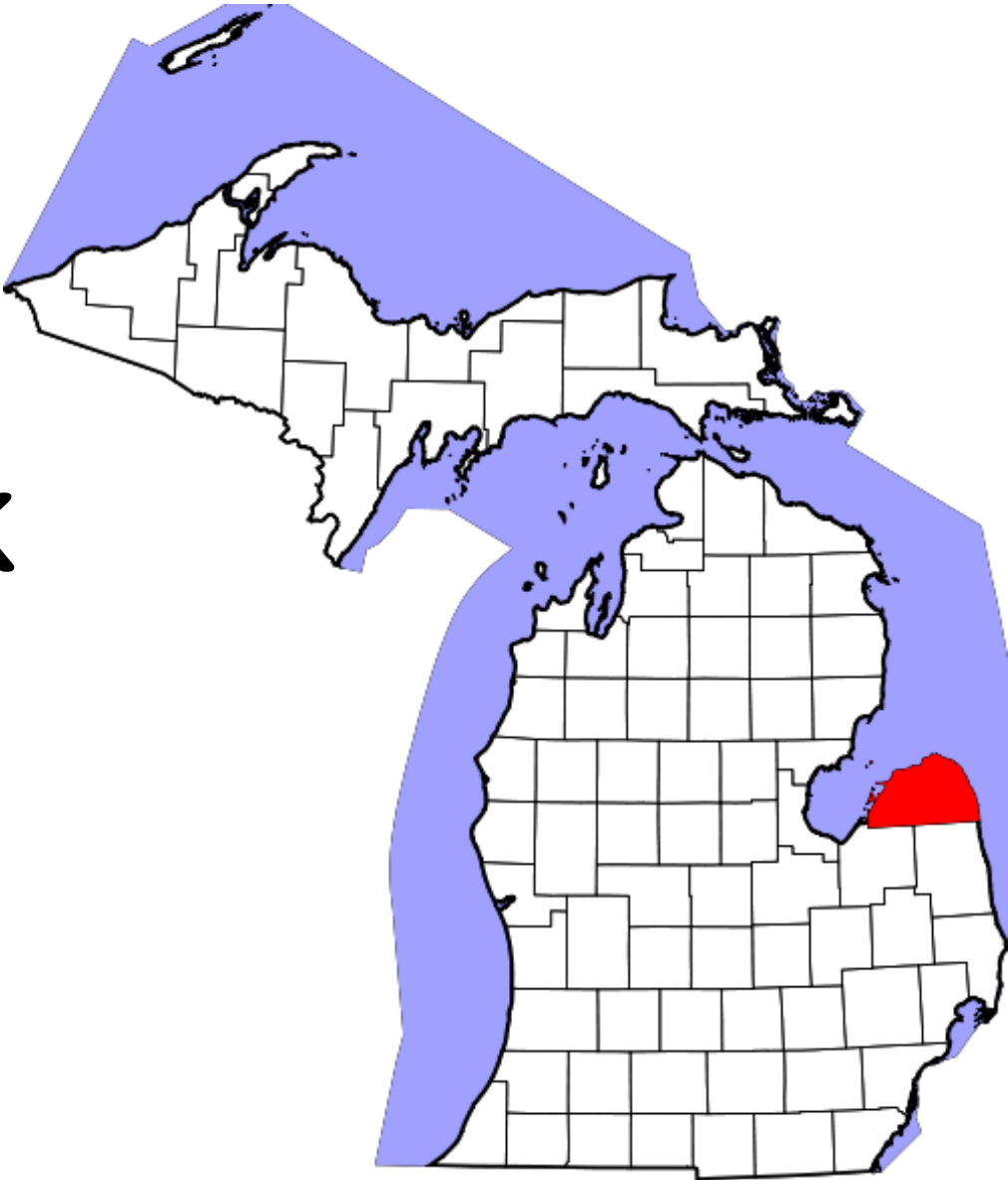

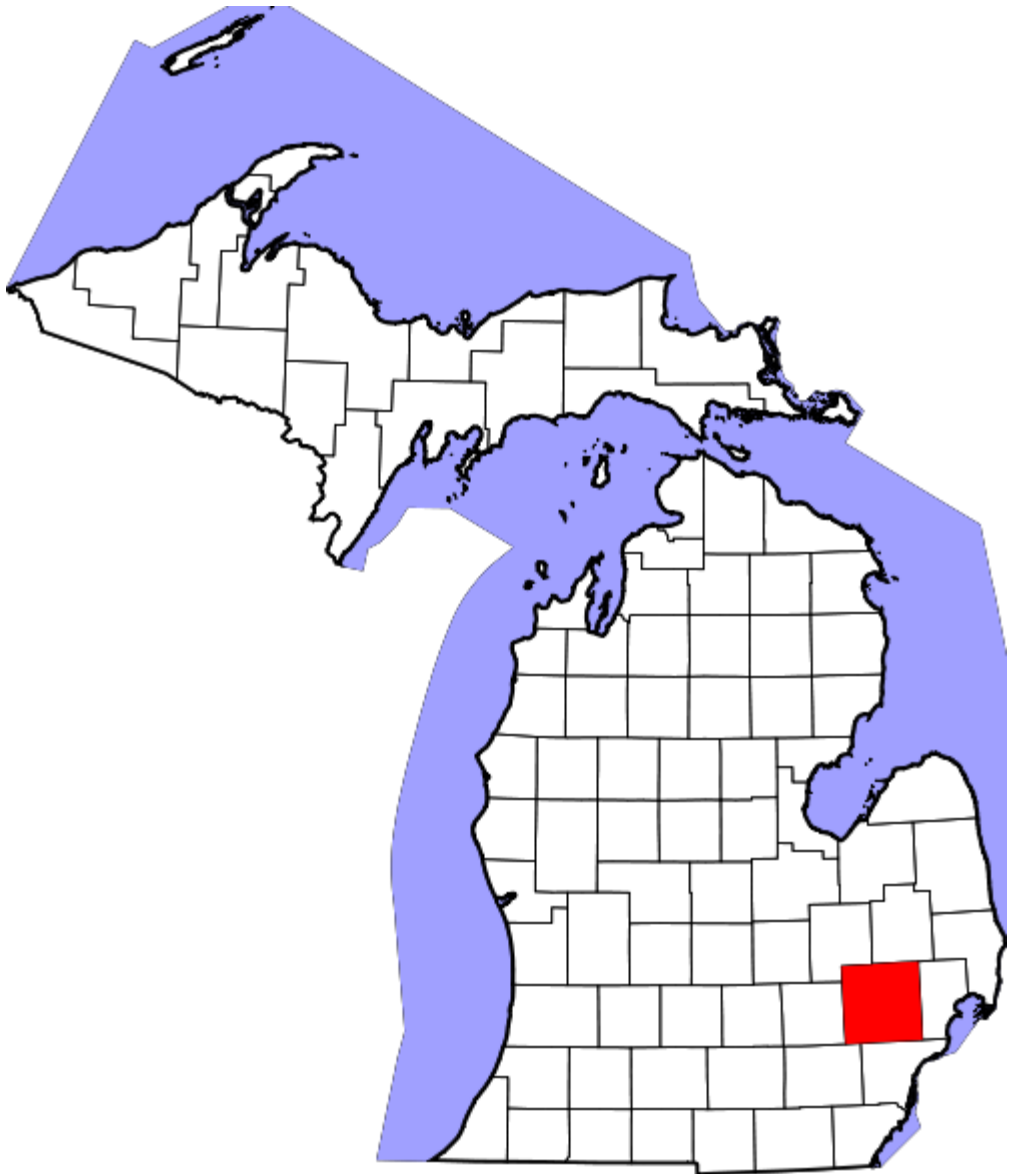
