# MAC is 125! (1898-2023)

- Formed on Feb. 1, 1898, as State Association of Supervisors of Michigan
- Oldest association representing local government units in Michigan
- Renamed Michigan Association of Counties in 1969
- Service expansions:
  - o 1955 First Executive Director (W.E. Dennison)
  - o 1979 Workers' Comp Fund
  - o 1986 Service Corporation

- 148 commissioners attending (24%)
- 53 of 83 counties represented (64%)
- Largest delegation: 6 Berrien, Kent, Macomb, Mecosta, Ottawa, Wayne
- Largest region: Region 3 (47)
- Exhibitors: 35






